




This year's choir season is successfully coming to an end, and I'd like to thank all of those members who have participated and shared their gift of song with the congregation.

# Church Directory available on your smartphone

Our church directory is available on most smartphones (depending on software version) for our members and regular attendees.

The first step is to go to the "app" store for your phone (iPhone or Android) and search for "universal church directory". The icon will look like the one shown at the top right of this article. Install the app.



**If your email address is shown in the directory**, you will receive an email from Universal Church Directory on Tuesday, May 2<sup>nd</sup> with your unique identifier code. When you open the app on your phone, it will prompt you for that code. You can copy and paste it from your email or hand type it in.

If your email address is not shown in the directory, call Linda at the office to update your directory listing to include your email address. We can then send out a unique identifier code to you.

Once you have entered the unique identifier code, select the "DOWNLOAD MY CHURCH DIRECTORY" button.

This app provides links to several features for our congregation in addition to the Church Directory. The church directory will give you the contact information for all of our members and attendees including buttons to phone, text, or email persons listed.

The office can update the contact information and photo in each listing. This includes adding new family members as well as new families. This will make it a great resource for everyone desiring to get in contact with each other.

If you find any errors in a listing, please notify the office so we can correct it.

# **Mission Impact Collections**

The Mission Barn, a ministry of the Western Pennsylvania Conference of The United Methodist Church and a regional partner of the United Methodist Committee on Relief, need cleaning kits, hygiene kits, and menstrual kits for distribution around the world as a part of our relief work through UMCOR.

There are specific lists of items needed for each kit including sizes and descriptions that are needed to allow the kit to be able to be shipped through customs anywhere in the world. These lists are available at our "information center" by the bulletin boards at the church or follow the link to the kit you are interested in putting together at umcmission.org/relief-supplies/.

Another option is that you can donate toward the cost of making kits through the offering plate. Be sure to mark your gift "relief kits".

All kits received by June 9<sup>th</sup> will be delivered to the Mission Barn collection at annual conference.


Next up is VBS! The countdown is on! We are still praying for additional participants and volunteers!





The Pantry has been going through a cleaning by Deb Catalano and Paula Boyd. They have been getting ready for the flea market and found things that were forgotten from when we did clothing and misc. Items. They probably took on more than they anticipated.

Last month I forgot to thank Pastor Alan for providing the potatoes for the Pantry. He received a notice that potatoes were available at Franklin UMC and offered to pick them up if I wasn't able to go for them. One of the Pastors in Cranberry was able to get them as far as Zelienople and he picked them up there. It is helpful to have connections. We ended up with 200 pounds of potatoes to be distributed.

This past month we had two different ladies tell me how thankful they are for the Pantry. They said it has made a difference and really helps them out. The one lady is working but only 15 hours a week. With the things she receives from the Pantry, she is able to make ends meet and support her special needs granddaughter and herself. The other woman is working part time at a restaurant and just signed up for Medicare. She is thankful for the Pantry and the things she receives.

We have just received a donation of money from the son of a deceased member. The money will be used to purchase ground meat and eggs for monthly distributions. We received a donation of pork before Christmas and have been distributing it on a monthly basis. We are thankful for all of the prayers and donations that the Pantry has received.

We had a visitor to the Pantry a week ago and she was amazed at what the Pantry does. She thought that the Pantry ran on donations alone and didn't realize that we buy what isn't donated. Food donations come on an irregular schedule and are not always what <u>are</u> needed. The Pantry is fortunate to have volunteers that are willing to shop and to help in the Pantry when needed. 
